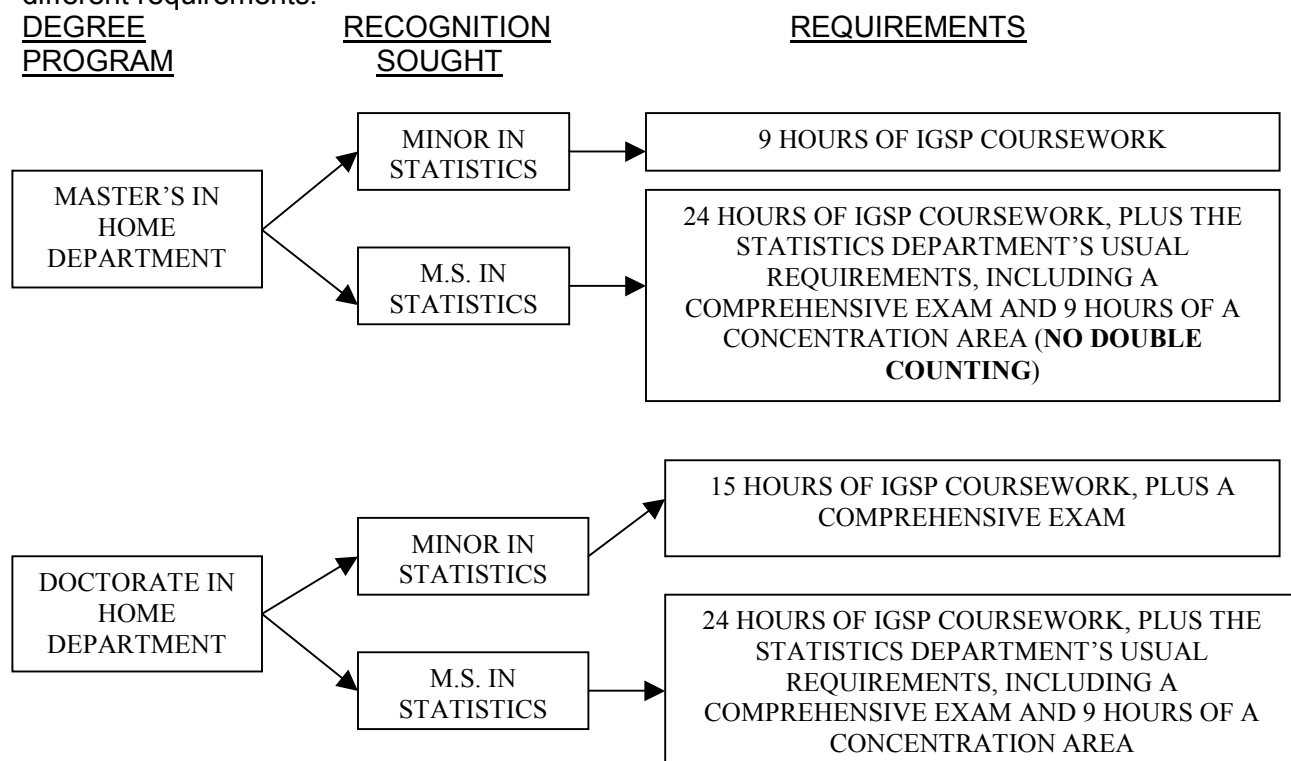

GUIDELINES FOR DEPARTMENTS

The Intercollegiate Graduate Statistics Program (IGSP) is designed to give formal recognition to graduate students who complement their graduate work by completing the requirements for an M.S. or a minor in the Department of Statistics. The advantage of this program is that coursework in statistics taken to meet your M.S./Ph.D. requirements may, under certain conditions, also be credited towards an M.S. or minor in statistics.

There are four separate categories for recognition of work in statistics, each with different requirements:



If your department would like to participate, the best starting point would be to contact your [college representative](#) for advice. Your college representative can go through the [IGSP flow chart](#) with you and advise you on the preparation of your materials for review by the IGSP Executive Committee.

The primary task for your department is to determine which subset of the above categories it wishes to make available to its students, and under what conditions. For example, when you review the list of [currently approved courses](#), you may want to

- allow some flexibility in the selection of courses, or
- restrict the choice of courses to a particular set of courses, or
- add your department's courses in statistics (if any) to the list of approved courses (subject to approval by the IGSP Executive Committee).
